No attempt has been made to show all drainage canals and ditches.

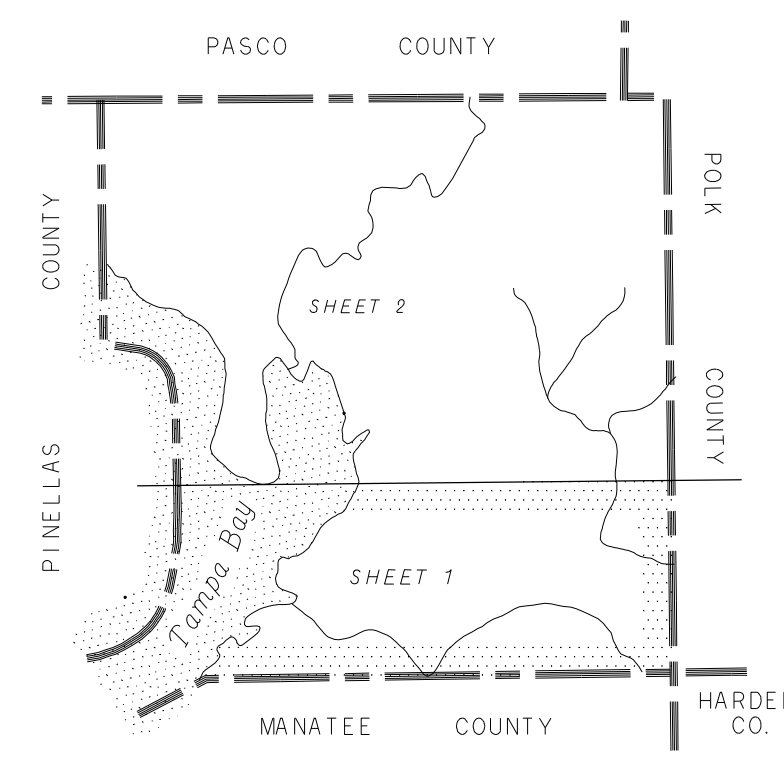
City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 2000.

In 2000, the population of Hillsborough County was 998,948. There are 1,040 square miles in the county.

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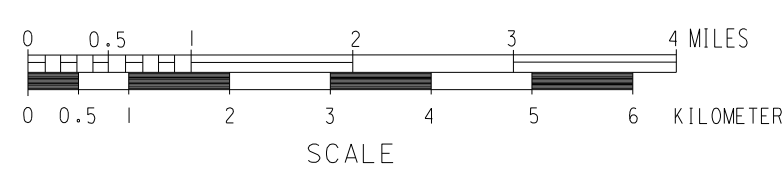
