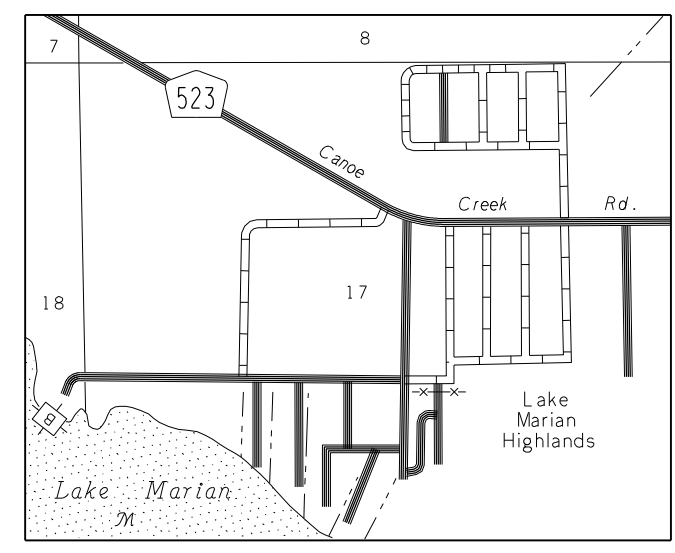

In congested rural areas local roads are indicated by a single line only for detail and for use in the county.

No attempt has been made to show all drainage canals and ditches.

City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 2000.

In 2000, the population of Osceola County was 172,493. There are 1,322 square miles in the county.

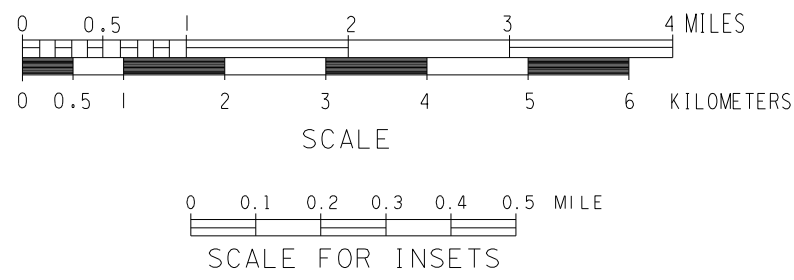
